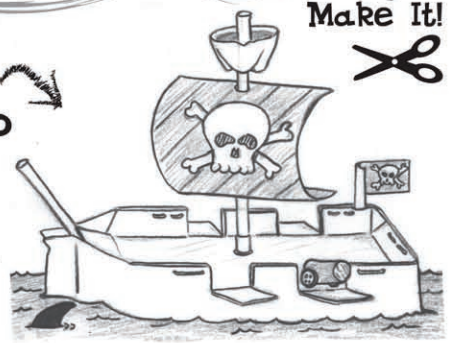


Scrap Project

Floatable Milk Carton Pirate Ship

Make It!

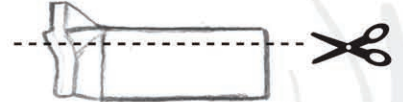


What You'll Need:

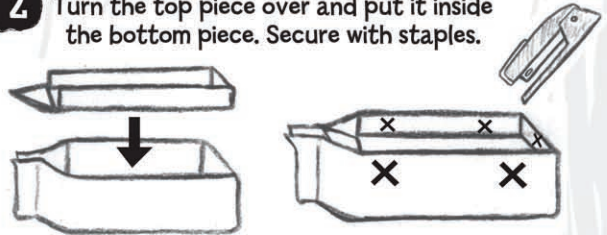


Ask for help from an adult before starting your boat.

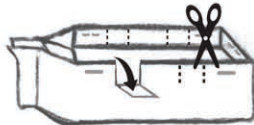
1 Cut the top of your milk carton off.



2 Turn the top piece over and put it inside the bottom piece. Secure with staples.



3 Cut out the side windows (called "gunports") for your cannon. Fold down the flaps.

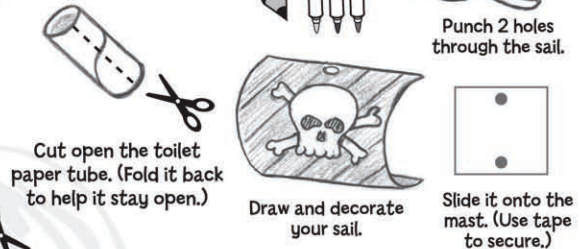


4 Put up the main mast. Carefully poke a hole through the floor of the ship. Push the end of the straw into the hole.



You can wrap a piece of tape around the end of the straw so it stands tight in the hole.

5 Make your sail.



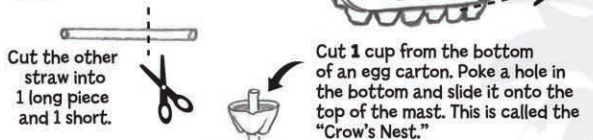
Cut open the toilet paper tube. (Fold it back to help it stay open.)

Punch 2 holes through the sail.

Draw and decorate your sail.

Slide it onto the mast. (Use tape to secure.)

6 Add details to your ship.



Cut the other straw into 1 long piece and 1 short.

Cut 1 cup from the bottom of an egg carton. Poke a hole in the bottom and slide it onto the top of the mast. This is called the "Crow's Nest."

Fit the long piece of straw into the front of the ship.

Cut a small rectangle of cardboard for your flag. Use the small piece of straw as the flagpole. Make a small cut in the straw, slide in the edge of the flag and tape the back.

7 Build your cannon.

Glue the buttons to both sides of the cork.



Captain Cork

You can use another cork to make your ship's captain. Make a hat from cardboard and draw a face.

This is called the "bowsprit."

You can tuck the flagpole between the 2 edges of the ship.

8 Launch your ship!
It's ready to sail the Seven Seas!
